- Identify program's strengths and areas that need to be improved
- Help child care programs (centers & group homes) follow state regulations and national standards for best practices re:
 - infection control, medication administration
 - facility and playground safety
 - Education about infection control, injury prevention, food safety & nutrition, environmental health, emergency preparedness
 - Care for children with special needs
- Provide health & safety telephone consultation to staff & parents in centers, family day care homes
- Provide resources & referrals (e.g. CHIP, WIC, health professionals with special expertise such as oral health, behavioral health)
